

Account Registration Information

1. To be eligible for this course, the student must have successfully completed a classroom driver education course online, or the student must have permission from his/her classroom driver education teacher. If the student receives permission from his/her classroom driver education teacher, the student will need to provide a school e-mail address for that teacher.
2. Complete the online application form on the next page.
3. Pay \$14 for the course.
4. Complete this course within 48 hours.

Upon successful completion of the 90-minute parent/teen course, you will receive an Affirmation of Attendance Certificate by mail. If you are a commercial, public or private school student, an e-mail communication confirming successful completion will be sent to your classroom teacher. Once you have received the certificate you can enroll in a state-approved behind-the-wheel driver education course.

Online Learning is not for everyone. Parents and teens must:

1. Make a personal commitment.
2. Schedule at least 90 minutes of time.
3. Be able to learn together online.
4. Be computer literate.
5. Have an e-mail address and Internet access.
